Edna Barrett Jackson Award (voice) Amount \$500

Open to any high school senior attending school in Linn County accepted to any accredited college, university or conservatory, and who will be earning credits in voice.

Phoebe Sherman Haman Award (Coe) Amount \$500

Open to any student from the state of Iowa who plans to enroll or is currently enrolled at Coe College and who will be earning credits in applied music.

Beethoven Club Tribute Award (instrumental) Amount \$500

Open to any high school senior attending school in Linn County accepted to any accredited college, university, or conservatory, and who will be earning credits in instrumental music.

Lucy Ambroz Keyboard Award Amount \$500

Open to any high school senior attending school in Linn County accepted to an accredited college, university or conservatory, and who will be earning credits in keyboard (piano, harpsichord, organ).

- **Applications must be emailed or postmarked on or before Saturday, January 11, 2014.**
- **Auditions for all awards will be held 1:00-5:00 pm Sunday, January 26, 2014 at Christ Episcopal Church, 220 40th St. NE, Cedar Rapids, IA 52402.**
- **Audition time is limited to ten minutes.**
- **Students may compete for one award only.**
- **Memorization will not be required. However, judges will award extra points for memorization.**
- **Contestants must bring an extra set of original music for the judges; copies will not be accepted.**
- **Recording of the auditions is not allowed. Only judges and timekeeper are allowed in the audition room.**

Vocalists must perform 1) one aria from an opera or oratorio or a composition of equal standard 2) one selection from the classical or romantic period, and 3) one modern selection.

Organists must perform a composition of high standard, preferably a Bach Prelude and Fugue.

Instrumentalists must perform one movement of a standard sonata or concerto or a composition of equal standard, and may also perform one or more compositions in contrasting style.

Original compositions should be submitted in manuscript form as well as live performance. Orchestral works may be recorded. Manuscripts will be returned.
