

Payment of School Fees

Payment of school fees can be completed in one of four ways:

1. **Payments for school fees may be made online** using the “School Cash On Line” system. You can access the system through Kennedy’s website at www.kenn.cr.k12.ia.us. Click on the School Cash Online icon and follow the directions.
2. **Payment for school fees may be mailed** to Kennedy High School. Payment receipts will be sent home through the U.S. mail.
3. **Payment for school fees may be paid using MasterCard, Visa or Discover** credit cards. Starting August 1st call our bookkeeper, Stephanie Cory at 558-1840 and give her your charge account information. We will process the charge and send the receipt home through the U.S. mail. If you prefer to stop by, please call in advance to make sure the bookkeeper will be available.
4. **Payment for school fees may be made directly to our bookkeeper.** You can drop off any fee payments and we will mail home your receipts. You are free to wait for a receipt if you prefer, but again, you may want to call first to make sure the bookkeeper is available.

SPECIAL NOTE: The Book fees, Booster Club Membership, Food & Nutrition payments for lunches, PTSA or FPA payments CANNOT be combined on one check. They must be written out on separate checks for each. You may combine payments for the “book fees” for all students at Kennedy onto one check.

The **Book Fee** (formally called the **consumable materials fee**) is charged to each high school student in the Cedar Rapids Community District is **\$93.00**. This fee is due by October 31, 2018. The \$93.00 covers all required school fees **with the exception of:**

- Driver Education fee
- Music instrumental rental fees/music uniform fees/**fine arts fees (band & vocal music)**
- Lock fee for individual interscholastic sports
- Special materials for personal projects
- Optional purchases (i.e. graphing calculator, dictionaries, notebooks, etc.)

This district Board of Education approved \$93.00 fee must be paid by all students. Students eligible for free or reduced price lunches can complete the “Application for Free/Reduced Lunch Form” **paying special attention to section “Waiver Benefits”, under the Parents’ Permission section part of E-Registration.**

Our three school-wide parent support groups are critical to the success of our co-curricular activities. We encourage you to become members of our **PTSA, Athletic Booster Club, and Performing Arts Foundation**. Please visit our website for information about these organizations that support Kennedy. If purchasing a membership, please make sure to write a separate check for each organization.

The student activity pass is a real bargain! The cost is \$40.00 and admits your student into all home athletic events (except state tournament series). Student activity passes are automatically included with the **Athletic Booster Club family membership** package. Activity passes will be provided for all students qualifying for free/reduced lunch. Activity passes also provide reduced prices for Fine and Performing Arts events.

We encourage you to **establish a breakfast/lunch account for your student prior to the beginning of the school year**. Payments can be made directly into your student’s account using the Food Service SendMoneyToSchool.com website. Payments can be mailed in as well, but cannot be on the same check as

your school fees (make check out to Kennedy Food Service). Please note your student's ID number on the memo line.

Please pay all school (yearly book fee) fees by October 31st, to insure your student's information is distributed accurately.
