IMMUNIZATIONS:

All students attending school in the Cedar Rapids Community School District must have an immunization card on file in the school they are enrolled.

Required immunizations:

- 1. DPT 3 doses required, at least one dose on or after age 4
- 2. Polio 3 doses required, at least one dose on or after age 4
- 3. Measles/Rubella -2 doses required . First dose >/= 12 months of age, 2nd dose no less than 28 days after first dose.
- 4. Hepatitis B 3 doses required if born on or after July 1, 1994
- 5. Varicella- 1 dose if born on or after September 15, 1997, or had a reliable history of natural disease.
