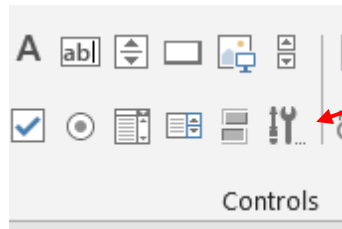


Inserting Youtube Videos into Powerpoint

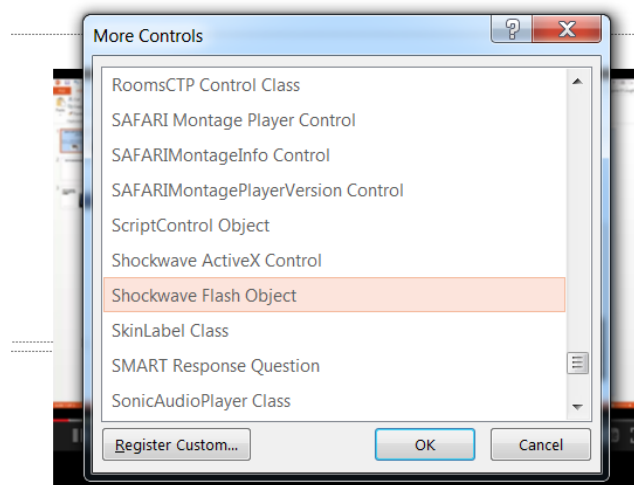
In Powerpoint:

Enable the Developer Tab: Go to File, Options, Customize Ribbon, Place a check in the Developer checkbox on the right side. Click OK.

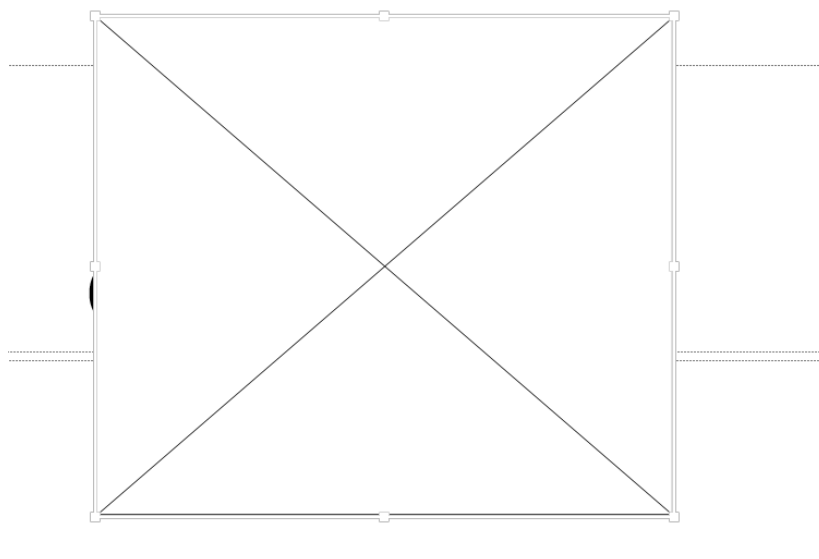
On the Developer Tab in the Ribbon: Click on the More Controls



Select Shockwave Flash Object near the bottom of the list.



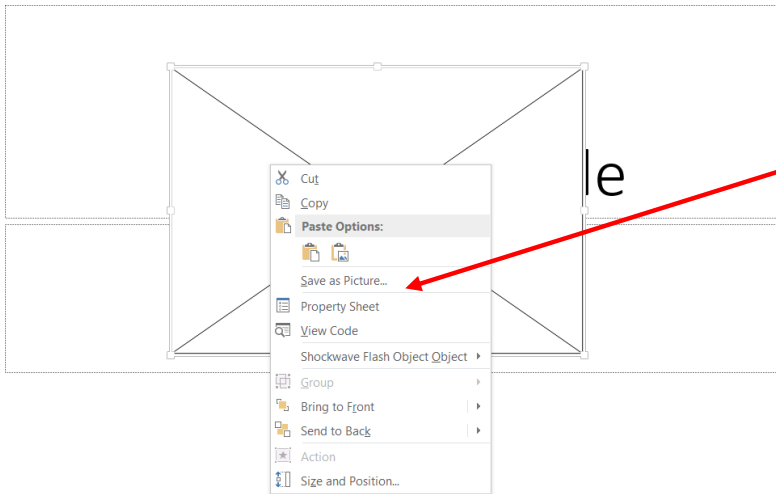
Once you select Shockwave Flash Object your mouse will switch to the cross bar symbol. Draw a square with your mouse and you will get a box on your slide.



Next, go to YouTube and find the video you wish to insert into the slide. Copy the URL address at the top by doing right click, copy.



Next, right click on the box with the square and select Properties



In the Properties window, find the line that says "Movie"paste the url for the Youtube video in the empty field.

Important:

In the Web Address:

Change: = to /

Delete: watch?

Close the window.

The box will appear white until you put the powerpoint into the slide show play mode.
