Job Shadow Info:

- Available to sophomores, juniors and seniors
- There are nearly 200 career options to choose from
- Student will spend 2-8 hours at a worksite (a one day commitment)
- Group Career Days are available throughout the year. There is Veterinary Science Day, Performing Arts Day, Skilled Trades Day, Legal Day, Mini-Medical School Day, Engineering Day and many others.

Practicum/Internship Info:

- Available to juniors and seniors
- 90 hour internships available in fall, spring and summer; 45 hour practicums available in winter and summer
- Students can receive 1 credit per semester
- Student may participate in a maximum of two internships (only one for credit)
- Internships are generally unpaid
- **Application deadlines do apply for both job shadows and internships.**
- **Applications are made through Mr. Goodlove's (attendance facilitator) office.**
