Workplace Learning Connection works in partnership with your school district to provide career exploration experiences at no cost to you!

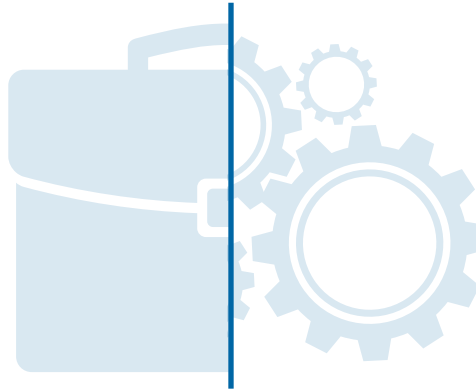
Participate in:

JOB SHADOW

Choose a career and spend part of a day in a small group or one-on-one with a career professional to learn more.

*Juniors and seniors can apply for one job shadow per year in late August/early September.

(Check with your school to see if sophomores are eligible)



INTERNSHIP

Receive between 45 and 90 hours of professional career experience at a local business. This is a great avenue to scholarship awards and future jobs!

*Available to students the summer before junior year through the spring of senior year.

Contact your school counselor to learn how to take advantage of these services at no cost to you!
